

## **REGULATIONS ON FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS WHEN TRANSFERRING TO ANOTHER BAR**

### Article 1

A trainee lawyer is indebted for the bar contribution to the Bar Council where he is registered on the list of trainee lawyers.

If a trainee lawyer transfers during the course of a calendar year to another bar, the bar contribution that he owes for that calendar year will still accrue fully to the Bar Council that he is transferring from, and he will not pay any contribution for that same calendar year to the Bar Council to which he transfers.

### Article 2

A lawyer is indebted for the bar contribution to the Bar Council where he is registered on the lawyers' roll.

If a lawyer, registered on the lawyers' roll, transfers during the course of a calendar year to another bar, the bar contribution that he owes for that calendar year will still accrue fully to the Bar Council that he is transferring from, and he will not pay any contribution for that same calendar year to the Bar Council to which he transfers.

The aforementioned arrangement will also apply if a lawyer, registered on the lawyers' roll of several Bar Councils, transfers during the course of a calendar year from a bar where he pays half of the annual contribution under Article 5 of the *Regulations on the Establishment of Several Offices* to another bar.

### Article 3

A lawyer or trainee lawyer who transfers from one bar to another must attach proof to his application for registration at the bar to which he is transferring that all the contributions for which he is liable at the bar from which he is transferring have been settled.
