

REGULATIONS REVOKING SEVERAL REGULATIONS OF THE BELGIAN NATIONAL BAR COUNCIL

Whereas the Belgian National Bar Council regulations cited in these regulations govern matters that since their entry into force have become governed by statute or radically altered by legislative initiatives, so that these regulations are outdated and there is also no further reason for replacing them.

Sole article

The following regulations of the Belgian National Bar Council are hereby revoked for the lawyers referred to in Article 498 of the Belgian Judicial Code:

- regulations of 12 June 1987, 1 December 1988, 17 May 1990, 20 February 1992 and 24 June 1993 on legal aid bureaus (BCVs) – remuneration of trainee lawyers;
- regulations of 22 April 1986 on legal expenses insurance – free choice of lawyer;
- regulations of 18 March 1971 on the effects of military service on the duration of training contracts;
- regulations of 30 January 1997 on access to the data of the Belgian population register of natural persons; and
- regulations of 28 November 1974 on disciplinary proceedings – conflict of jurisdiction between two bars.
