

Regulations on the application of the Code of Conduct for European Lawyers

1. The Code of Conduct for European Lawyers, as adopted at the plenary meeting of the CCBE on 28 October 1988, and amended at the plenary meetings of 28 November 1998, 6 December 2002 and 19 May 2006, was declared applicable to the cross-border activities referred to in this code for all lawyers referred to in Article 498 of the Belgian Judicial Code.
2. In accordance with Articles 496 and 507 of the Belgian Judicial Code, these regulations replace the regulations of the Belgian National Bar Council of 12 October 1989 on the approval of the code of conduct for lawyers of the European Community.
